- Participants are responsible for submitting their own visa application to the appropriate Chinese Consulate or Embassy.
- If the number of applicants is insufficient for the Confucius Institute to run the tour, we reserve the right to cancel, in which case funds will be returned.
- Tour positions will be reserved upon receipt of full payment, on a first received, first reserved basis.

**CANCELLATION POLICY**

1. In the event that a student's application for a visa is unsuccessful, or an offer of a place is withdrawn, or the Confucius Institute at the University of Western Australia is unable to provide the programme, tuition fees paid in advance are fully refundable. However if the offer was made on the basis of incorrect or incomplete information being supplied by the student, the University is entitled to retain an administration fee of AUD\$250.
2. A student who withdraws from a programme or course prior to its commencement shall be eligible for a refund less AUD\$250 for administrative expenses.
3. Tuition fees are not refundable upon commencement of a teaching term.
4. No refund of fees will be given to a student who is requested to leave Australia or China due to a breach of their student visa conditions.
5. No refund of fees will be given to a student who is requested to leave the University of Western Australia, Zhejiang University or Beijing Institute of Education due to a serious breach of the University's regulations.
6. The Confucius Institute reserves the right to cancel any programmes and in any such event all monies received will be refunded.
